E lawe mai i nā mea e mālama ana i ke olakino e like me ka ‘ōmole wai, ke kāma‘a, ka māmalu, apwa.


Inā loa‘a, e lawe mai i ka pū wili kui uila no ka wāwahi ‘ana i ke ka‘a paikau ma hope.



DROP-OFF POINTS

- County building lot on Aupuni St. Drop off riders and exit through Aupuni St. Participants can walk down to the staging area.
- Use the makai parking lot nearest Pauahi St. (across Bayfront Motors or Turn into Kumu St. (Soccer field road). Participants can walk to the staging area from there.
- Bayfront Park across the street of the staging area; there is no parking allowed in that area because we will be using that area as a staging area
